

TEACHING FOR TOMORROW

Understand the world of e-learning and become the lecturer of tomorrow!

The joint cross-border course "TEACHING FOR TOMORROW" is now open for enrollment. The course aims to give lecturers the competences necessary to design and deliver online courses.

The course is particularly aimed at lecturers who have an interest in online teaching and learning and lecturers who already undertake online teaching and learning or expect to do so in the future. Course materials are state of the art and reflect the newest developments and research in the field.

Furthermore, the course provides lecturers with an opportunity to network across the partner institutions and find collaboration partners with a view to designing and delivering joint online courses for students.

COURSE DELIVERY

The course is delivered mainly online via both synchronous and asynchronous activities. A laptop, a good Internet connection and a headset is needed. E-learning experts from the 7 partner institutions jointly teach the course, thus assuring competent lecturers in all modules.

COURSE CONTENTS AND STRUCTURE

The course consists of the following 6 modules:

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| Module 1 | The virtual learning environment and e-learning tools |
| Module 2 | Introduction to online learning |
| Module 3 | Educational design and design of course materials and activities |
| Module 4 | Delivery of online courses/The online lecturer |
| Module 5 | Web 2.0 and social media |
| Module 6 | E-assessment |

THE OVERALL LEARNING OUTCOMES OF THE COURSE ARE FOR PARTICIPANTS TO

- develop skills and confidence in using a virtual learning environment including a wide range of e-learning tools.
- develop a deeper understanding of e-learning tools and their uses with regard to learning and assessment scenarios.
- gain knowledge of teaching and assessment methods, best practices and educational design for online and for blended learning.
- gain knowledge of social media and how to integrate these into teaching and learning activities and understand the implications of doing so.
- identify and reflect upon the efficacy of the learning outcomes of different online learning activities and e-assessment methods.
- be able to design online teaching, learning and assessment activities.
- be able to design engaging online course materials.
- develop skills and confidence as an online lecturer.

COURSE INFORMATION

The course is open to German and Danish lecturers from the 7 partner institutions of the Videnregion / Wissensregion cross-border network.

PREREQUISITES AND EQUIPMENT

No prerequisites.

Laptop, good internet connection and headset needed.

ECTS POINTS AND DIPLOMA

The course consists of 6 chronologically planned modules. Participants **earn badges** for each module. **A course diploma** is earned upon completing the full course. This diploma ensures the participant **5 ECTS**.

COURSE PERIOD

20 October 2014 – 28 February 2015.

NO COURSE FEE

The course is **free** for lecturers from partner institutions.

LANGUAGE

The course will be taught in English.

REGISTRATION

Registration deadline: **31 August 2014** Limit of 70 participants (maximum 10 from each institutions). The course will only be held if at least 20 participants enroll.
